

Ġgantija Temples

The Ġgantija Temples consist of two megalithic temples surrounded by a massive common boundary wall dating back to between 3600 BC and 3200 BC. The name is derived from the Maltese word 'ġgant' which mean giant.

Opening Times:

1st October till 31st May: 09.00 - 17.00hrs. Last admission at 16.30hrs.

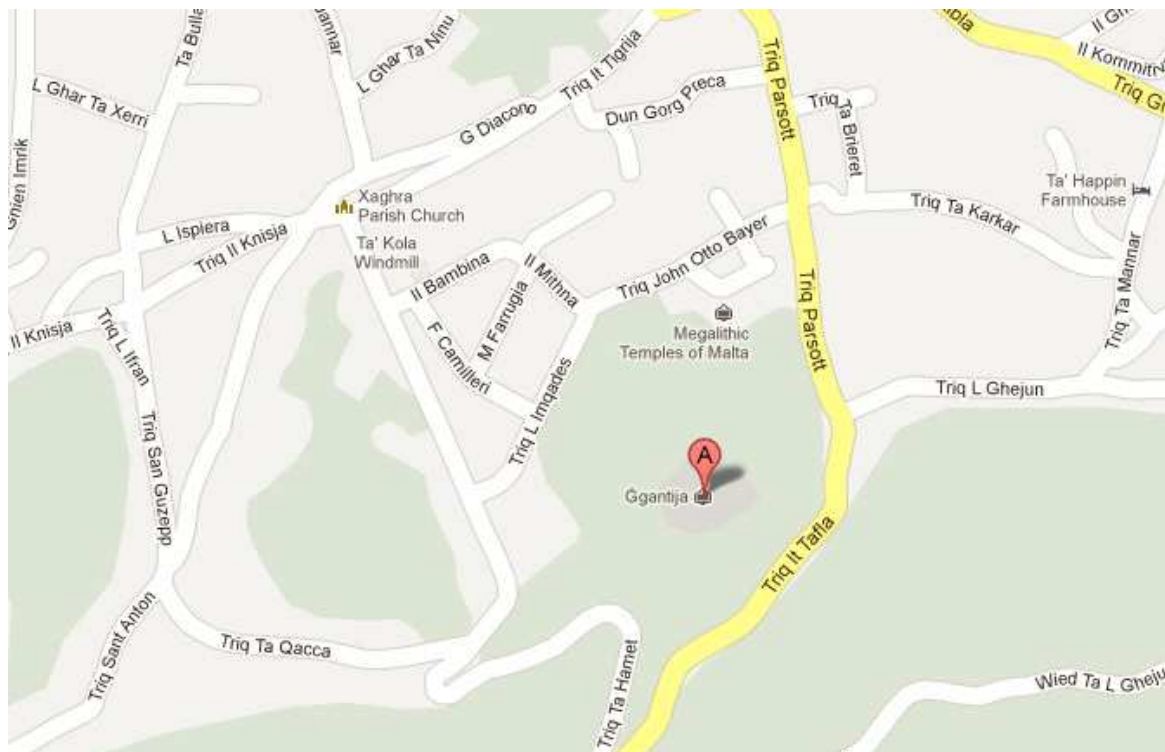
1st June till 30th September: 09.00-18.00hrs. Last admission at 17.30hrs.

Closed: 24, 25 & 31 December. 1 January & Good Friday.

Tickets: Adults (18-59 years): **€9.00**/ Youths, Students & Seniors: **€7.00**/ Children (6-11 years): **€5.00**/ Infants (1-5 years): Free. Combined ticket that also includes admission to **Ta' Kola Windmill**, also in Xagħra .

How to get there: Take a bus to the town of **Xagħra** and follow the signs.

Other Heritage Malta sites in the vicinity: **Ta' Kola Windmill** which is one of the few surviving windmills on the Maltese Islands dating back to the Knights' period. **Ġgantija Temples standard ticket also includes admission to the Ta' Kola Windmill.**
