

## Għar Dalam

Għar Dalam is a site of great scientific importance. Animal remains from the late Ice Age (500,000 to 10,000 years ago) have been discovered inside this cave together with the remains of first human settlers dating back to some 7,000 years ago. The site consists of a “Victorian” display, a didactic display, gardens and the cave.
