

Hal Saflieni Hypogeum

This truly unique site is inscribed on the **UNESCO World Heritage List**. The Hypogeum consists of halls, chambers and passages hewn out of the living rock and covering some 500m². The complex dates back to about 4000 BC, and was used over a span of many centuries, up to c. 2500 BC. It is dug on three levels – the **upper level**, the **middle level** and the **lower level**.

Opening Times: Monday to Sunday: 09.00 - 16.00hrs.

Closed: 24, 25 & 31 December, 1 January & Good Friday.

<u>Pre-booked tickets</u>: Adults (18-59 years): €30.00/ Youths, Students & Seniors: €15.00/ Children (6-11 years): €12.00. Purchase tickets early since tours are often sold out weeks in advance. Please note that due to health and safety reasons, children 6 years and under will not be admitted inside the Hypogeum. Tickets are not available at the door.
