

Mnajdra Temples

Mnajdra occupies a spectacular location overlooking the Mediterranean Sea and the Island of Filfla. It is found just 500m downhill from Ħaġar Qim Temples and consists of three prehistoric buildings overlooking a common oval forecourt. One of these buildings, the South Temple, is perfectly positioned to mark the sunrise at the start of each season.

Mnajdra is a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, inscribed as part of 'The Megalithic Temples of Malta' in the World Heritage List.

Opening Times:

1st April till 30th September: 09.00 - 18.00hrs (last admission at 17.30hrs)

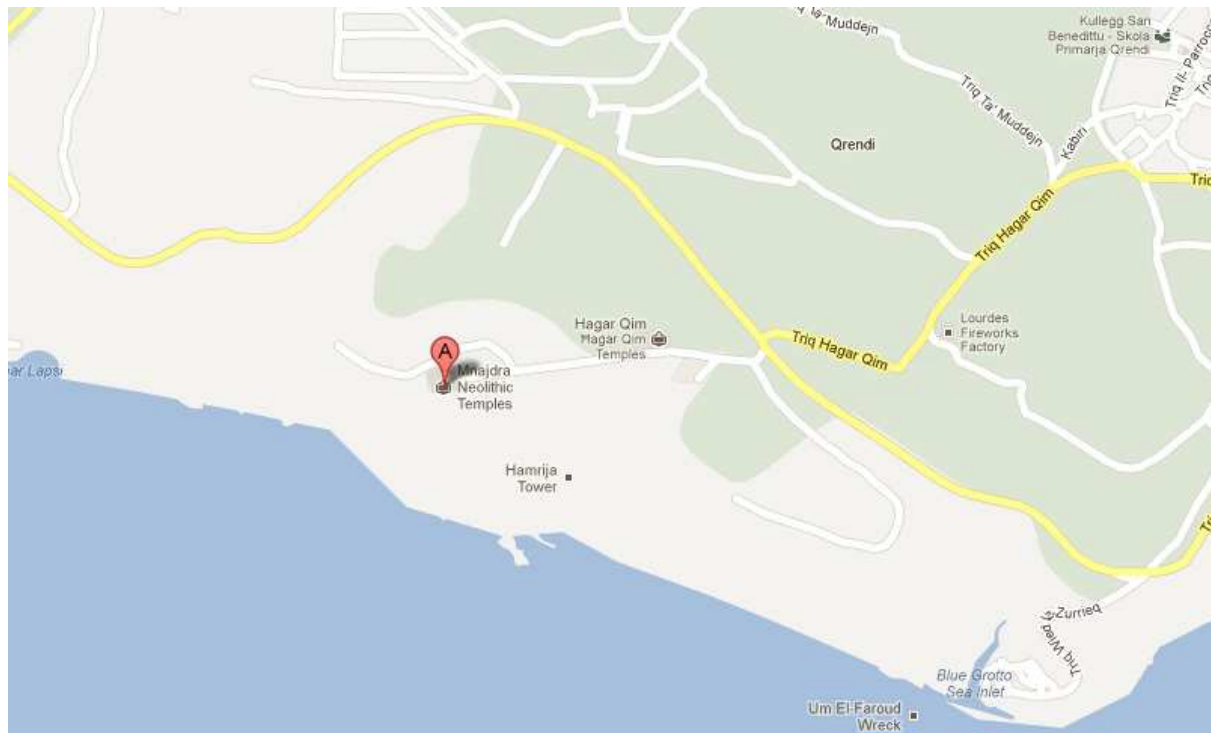
1st October till 31st March: 09.00 - 17.00hrs (last admission at 16.30hrs)

Closed: 24, 25 & 31 December, 1 January & Good Friday.

Tickets: Adults (18-59 years): **€10.00**/ Youths, Students & Seniors: **€7.50**/ Children (6-11 years): **€5.50**/ Infants (1-5 years): **Free**. Ticket includes Ħaġar Qim Temples, Mnajdra Temples, and the Visitor Centre.
