

Ta' Kola Windmill

Ta' Kola Windmill is one of the few surviving windmills on the Maltese Islands dating back to the Knights' Period. It is a fine example of Gozo's rural economy and domestic life during past centuries.

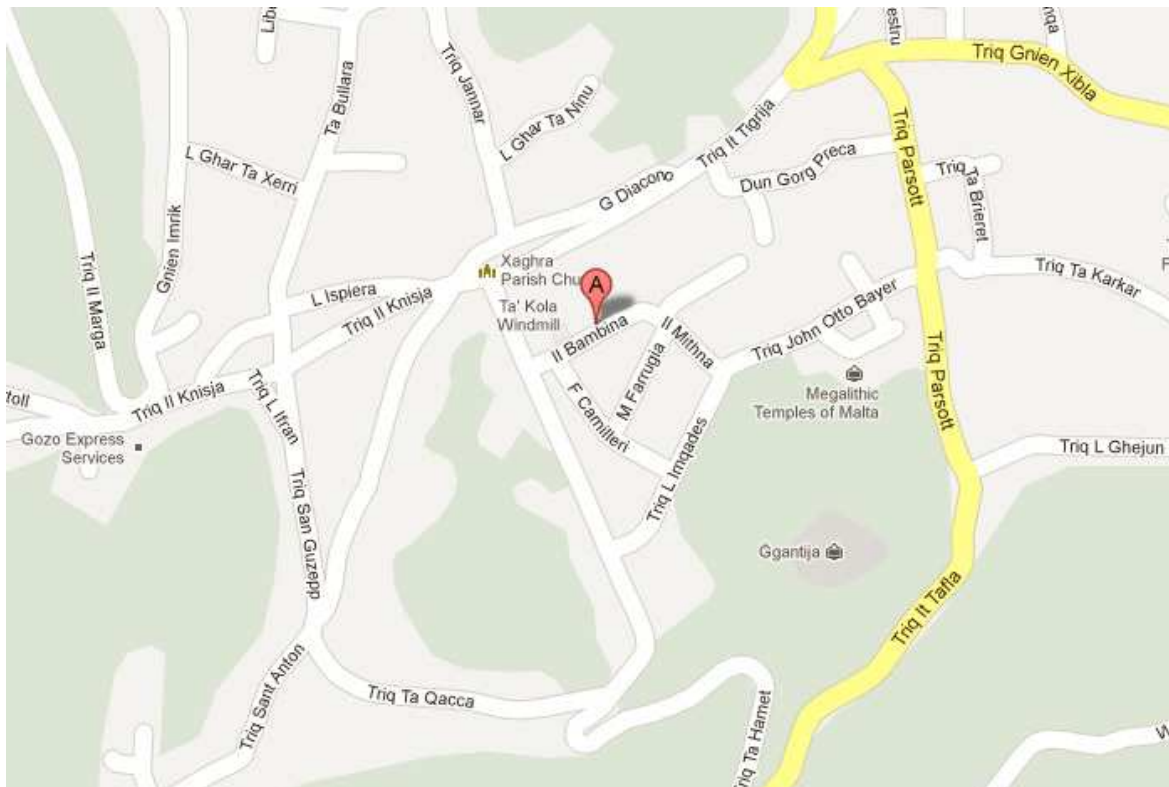
Opening Times: Monday to Sunday: **09.00 - 17.00hrs**. Last admission at 16.30hrs.

Closed: 24, 25 & 31 December. 1 January & Good Friday.

Tickets: Adults (18-59 years): **€9.00**/ Youths, Students & Seniors: **€7.00**/ Children (6-11 years): **€5.00**/ Infants (1-5 years): Free. This is a combined ticket that also includes admission to the **Ġgantija Temples**, located only 5 minutes away from Ta' Kola Windmill.
