

The Inquisitor's Palace

The Inquisitor's Palace is an architectural gem. Situated in the heart of Vittoriosa (Birgu), it was for centuries an enclave of power, hosting for 224 years the Inquisitor and Apostolic Delegate for Malta.

It is today the only Inquisitor's Place open to the public in the world, representative of the chequered history and European heritage of the Maltese islands.

How to get there: Vittoriosa is one of the three fortified cities, together with Cospicua and Senglea. These are enclosed by a line of fortification that the Knights of St John constructed during their stay in Malta.

Take a bus to Vittoriosa (Birgu) and walk towards the town centre.
