

## National Museum of Archaeology

On display a spectacular range of artefacts from the Neolithic period to the Phoenician, covering a span of **5000 years of Maltese archaeology**, from 5200 BC till 218 BC. Highlights include 'The Sleeping Lady', 'The Venus of Malta', the 'Horus and Anubis' pendant and a ceramic anthropomorphic sarcophagus.
