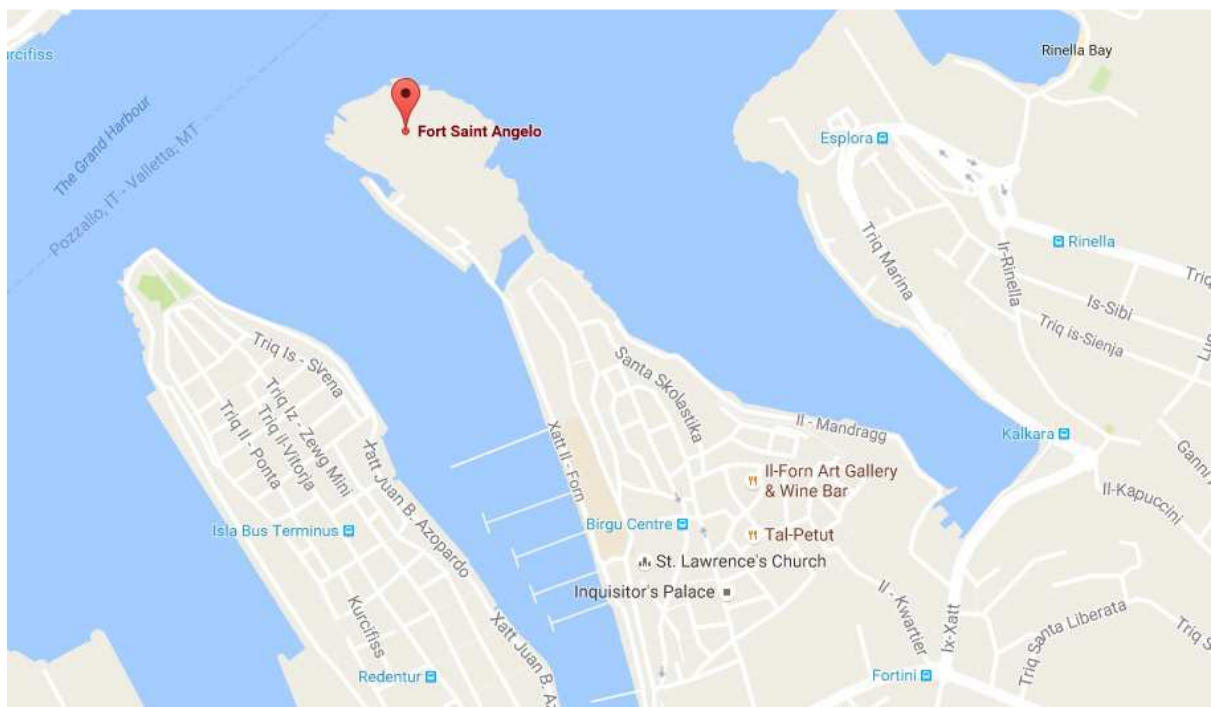
**Opening Times:** Monday to Sunday: **09.00 - 17.00hrs** (last admission at 16.30hrs).

**How to get there:** Vittoriosa is one of the three fortified cities, together with Cospicua and Senglea. These are enclosed by a line of fortification that the Knights of St John constructed during their stay in Malta.

Take a bus to Vittoriosa (Birgu) and walk along the Vittoriosa Waterfront towards Fort St Angelo.
