

### Ta' Ħaġrat

Situated close to the Mgarr Parish Church, Ta' Ħagrat dates to around 3600BC and bears witness to the earliest phases of megalithic temple construction in Maltese prehistory.

**Opening Times:** Monday to Sunday: **09.00 - 17.00hrs**. Last admission: 16.30hrs

Closed: 24, 25 & 31 December. 1 January & Good Friday.
